



A quick guide to your waste and recycling services

Weekly

	(Box 1) Plastic bottles + tins/cans/aerosols/foil	Plastic bottles only. Food/drink cans and tins, metal biscuit tins, pet food cans, foil, aerosols.
	(Box 2) Glass + textiles Textiles must be bagged (carrier bag size or smaller)	Glass bottles and jars. Clothes, paired shoes (please bag first).
	Paper + cardboard Cardboard and paper must be inside the bag	Paper, envelopes, catalogues, newspapers, magazines, grey card, brown cardboard.
	Food waste Use a compostable or old plastic bag or newspaper to line your caddy if you wish	Including dairy, meat/fish, rice, vegetables, fruit, bread, pastries, plate scrapings, leftovers.

Fortnightly

	Garden waste If subscribed. Sign up or renew online: www.fdean.gov.uk/gardenwaste	Lawn cuttings, tree/hedge prunings, garden plants/weeds, leaves, twigs, bark.
	Small electricals/electronics + batteries Put in any carrier bag (or smaller) and leave on top of your refuse bin	Including kettles, toasters, irons, hair dryers, power tools, tablets, cameras. Household batteries.
	Non-recyclable waste (energy from waste)	Such as nappies, margarine tubs, yoghurt pots, crisp packets, plastic film, pet food pouches.
